
## **Key Findings**

- 82 participants on 20 teams took part in the event this year.
- This year will be the last year that this event will take place as it is no longer financially viable.

#### Details

Waterfowl Warmup is a fundraiser in support of Report A Poacher (RAP). Proceeds from the event support efforts to educate the public about responsible hunting and angling and the negative impacts of poaching. In all, 20 teams participated in Waterfowl Warmup this year.
