### **Introduction**

The *Caring for Shorelines* booklet is an existing riparian resource that has become outdated and will be rewritten and republished in 2016. Nature Alberta approached Alberta Conservation Association (ACA) and Alberta Environment and Parks to combine resources and knowledge to produce a more robust riparian resource for the public within their Living Edge program. A memorandum of understanding exists between the partners, with ACA committed to covering printing costs and reviewing content.

### **Methods**

We are currently coordinating resources to develop the new riparian resource.
