



2022 Taber Pheasant Festival Official Raffle Rules

The following raffle tickets for the 2022 Taber Pheasant Festival will be available for purchase with no cash equivalent awarded:

- Raffle A – Tikka T3x Lite Veil Wideland 6.5 Creedmoor Rifle: 450 red tickets are printed and sold for \$20 each.
 - Raffle B – Sako S20 Precision 6.5 PRC Rifle: 600 green tickets are printed and sold for \$20 each.
 - Raffle C – Beretta A400 Xtreme Plus 12-Gauge, 28" Barrel Semi-Automatic Shotgun: 600 blue tickets are printed and sold for \$20 each.
 - Raffle D – Benelli Super Black Eagle (SBE) 3 12-Gauge, 28" Prairie Shotgun: 650 yellow tickets are printed and sold for \$20 each.
 - Raffle E – Beretta Ultraleggero Over/Under 12-Gauge, 28" Barrel Shotgun with Kickoff: 1000 purple tickets are printed and sold for \$20 each.
 - Raffle F – Beretta A400 Upland Wood 12-Gauge, 28" Shotgun with Kickoff: 600 pink tickets are printed and sold for \$20 each.
 - Raffle G – Game Bird Hunt Site for 2023 Taber Pheasant Festival (3 winning draws – each draw wins 3 hunt times): 1000 orange tickets are printed and sold for \$10 each.
1. All raffle tickets are only sold to Alberta residents.
 2. Raffle tickets will be sold online starting June 1, 2022, and also available at the office the week of the festival. They can be purchased by cash, AMEX, Visa, or MasterCard.
 3. Raffle ticket purchasers must be at least 18 years of age.
 4. Alberta Conservation Association (ACA) staff and their family members residing at the same address are prohibited from purchasing raffle tickets.
 5. Tickets must have the purchasers full name, address, and phone number printed in legible ink. If the name on the ticket is illegible by the representative making the draw, the ticket will be declared invalid.

6. The raffle prizes will be drawn on October 20, 2022, at Taber Community Centre during the Taber Pheasant Festival Celebration Banquet.
7. The draw will be witnessed by ACA staff or all in attendance at the location indicated above. The winning ticket will be drawn manually from the draw barrel by an individual who does not have a ticket in the draw, in a random manner. Only the person making the draw will put their arm into the draw barrel and will have no clothing on their arm below their elbow.
8. The winner must present valid ID or matching ticket, along with valid PAL (where applicable) to claim their prize. The winner has up to one year to claim their prize, but most likely will accept the prize on the draw date. If the winner has not claimed their prize and cannot be located after one full year from the draw date, the prize will be donated to a charitable association, based on the approval of the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission.
9. No refunds will be offered once a ticket has been purchased unless the ticket was purchased in error (for example, out-of-province resident).
